ALL ENTRIES SHOULD BE DECORATED (floats, people in costumes, etc.) The only exceptions to this are entries that are unique (Queen Floats, antique cars, horse and buggies, etc.).

Entries will be judged in the following categories:

- 1. Grand Marshal's Choice Best Overall
- 2. Best Queen's Float
- 3. Best Antique Unit
- 4. Most Original Unit
- 5. Best Equestrian Unit

TO BE JUDGED, YOU MUST BE IN THE LINEUP BY 11:00 am

Please respect the private property of Montrose's residents while in the lineup. Please keep horses, motor vehicles, etc., off the sidewalks and lawns. Do not leave trash or other refuse behind. We will fine anyone for damage that needs repair.

People walking along side of the entries should all be in matching clothing or costumes to make them an integral part of the unit. Walkers must keep up with their units.

Participants with animals in their group are required to provide their own waste disposal unit (pooper scooper).
